Grant Name	Community Energy Saving Programme (CESP)
Funder	Central Government: Departments of Communities and Local Government and Department of Energy and Climate Change
Objective	<p>The Community Energy Saving Programme (CESP), is designed to provide a whole-house energy efficiency approach to households throughout Britain, concentrated on those living in areas of high deprivation.</p> <p>CESP will be administered by Ofgem and delivered through the development of community-based partnerships (involving local authorities) along with suppliers and generators.</p>
Eligibility	<p>The government departments responsible for the initiative, CLG and DECC, have stated they are particularly keen to see housing associations apply for funding.</p> <p>Eligibility is expected to be based on evidence of fuel-poverty and the funds will be directed to areas of high deprivation.</p>
Amount	Of the £1bn energy efficiency package announced by the Prime Minister in September 2008, £350m was earmarked for CESP.
Timeframe	It is anticipated that following a consultation period on the exact design and operation of the programme, which was launched on 12 February 2009, the CESP fund will be open for bids in mid-2009.
